Sylatech Ltd is committed to the responsible sourcing of 3TG minerals throughout its supply chain and recognises that we have a responsibility not to support to the violence and human rights violations associated with the mining of conflict minerals.

- Sylatech supports the aims and objectives of the U.S and E.U regulations on the supply of conflict minerals.
- Sylatech does not knowingly procure conflict minerals from sources that directly or indirectly benefit or finance armed groups and their associated human rights abuses.
- Sylatech has identified its products which include tin, tungsten, tantalum, and gold.
- Sylatech works with its supply chain to ensure they undertake due diligence in an effort to ensure that conflict minerals are being sourced from mines and smelters/refiners outside areas defined by regulation, or from mines and smelters/refiners which have been certified by an independent third party as 'conflict free', if sourced within the defined areas.
